General information, Bulletin

Execution: According to WKF rules.

Kumite categories:

In individual categories straight knock-out system with repechage, two third places. In team categories straight knock-out system, no repechage, two third places.

In categories with 4 competitors there will be straight knock-out system and a third-place playoff

In categories with 3 competitors there will be round robin

Kata categories:

The flag system will be used for judging. In individual categories straight knock-out system with repechage, two third places. In team categories straight knock-out system, no repechage, two third places.

In categories with 4 competitors there will be straight knock-out system with a third-place playoff

There will be no kata categories with round robin

In 8-9 years old categories only Pinan Katas are allowed, the same kate is allowed in every round except the final and third-place playoff.

In 10-11 years old categories only Pinan Katas are allowed in the preliminary rounds. In the final and third-place playoff the competitors can choose a Wado-kai Tokui Kata. Competitors must alternate between two katas and in the final or third-place playoff they have to perform a third (Tokui) kata.

From the 12-13 years old categories and above the execution will be according to WKF rules. Every round a different kata has to be performed. Pinan katas are allowed.

Team Kata categories:

In age group 8-11 years only pinan katas are allowed in the preliminary rounds. The teams can perform the same kata in every preliminary round. For the final or third-place playoff a new kata must be performed.

In age group 12-15 years competitors have to alternate between two katas in preliminary rounds and have to perform a third kata in the final or third-place playoff. Pinan kata is not compulsory.

From age group 16-17 years and above the execution will be according to WKF rules. Every round a new kata has to be performed. Pinan katas are allowed.

Protective gear: According to WKF rules

The use of The use of teeth protector, seiken-protector, shin bone protector and feet protector is compulsory in all categories.

In WKF categories breast protectors are compulsory for women.

There are no brand restrictions, but protective gear must be WKF type.

The use of worn out protective gear is not allowed!

Candidation rules:

Every competitor can only engage in his/her respective age group. Exempt are competitors of the U21 and veteran categories, who can engage in +18 categories as well.

A competitor in a given age group can only engage in one weight.

A country can nominate a maximum of 4 competitors in individual categories.

In team categories a country can nominate two teams. Exempt are the +18 and veteran categories where only one team may be nominated from a country.

Every competitor can engage in only one kata and one kumite team. Competitors can be engaged in higher age groups but in this case they can not engage in their original age group. (For example a kadet competitor can be engaged in a junior kumite team, but he/she can not be engaged in the kadet team).
